



Vaccines

All dogs that are groomed at So Fetch & So Clean are required to have an up to date Rabies vaccine before they will be groomed. Rabies is required by Kansas Law.

I do not require Bordatella (kennel cough) or Distemper/Parvo vaccine because I do not keep dogs longer than a few hours and they are separated. However, if your dog has been treated for Kennel Cough, they **CAN NOT** be groomed for 2 weeks after they have finished their medications. All Dogs are kept in separated kennels until the owner arrives.

Any puppies who are displaying diarrhea, vomiting or lethargy need to be seen by their veterinarian for possible Parvo immediately before they can be groomed.

Health Issues

ANY medical issues your dog has, needs to be disclosed to your groomer at scheduling because extra grooming time may need to be scheduled so I can make sure your dogs needs are met. It is very important that we know about issues such as:

- Seizures
- Thyroid Issues
- Heart Issues such as murmurs, heart worms, etc
- Allergies
- Ear Infections, or hearing loss
- Hot Spots
- New lumps or bumps
- Arthritis
- Limping or walking differently
- New skin issues or hair loss
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Breathing funny or making unusual noises
- Changes in body shape or weight
- Eye Problems or blindness

Intact Females

I WILL NOT groom intact females when they are in heat and actively bleeding. I do this because it changes the atmosphere in the shop and can make male dogs, whether fixed or not, more agitated. Also, when doing any pre shaving on an intact female, I have to stop and sanitize all the equipment and tools used multiple times during the grooming session.

Pregnancy

A dog who is expecting needs grooming just like any other dog would, perhaps even more so. I do have experience grooming pregnant dogs and I am willing to continue to groom them however, pregnancy requires additional time, a gentle touch and limited stress to the dog. This results in longer groom times and limits on what can and cannot be done.

If your dog shows **ANY** signs that it is in distress and your groomer feels it is in the dogs best interest, the groom will be stopped and the owner will be called immediately. I reserve the right to refuse service.
