



At So Fetch & So Clean, I love all dogs but due to limited kennel space, staff and groom time and physical limitations, I can only take a limited number of certain large breed dogs. These include:

- Any Dogs approximately 50lb or more
- Golden Retrievers
- Labrador Retrievers
- Huskies
- German Shepherds
- And yes, some Doodle Breeds

I am only able to accommodate a couple giant breeds on my schedule due to my own physical limitations and space. These breeds include:

- Any Dog approximately 80lb or more
- Newfoundlands
- Great Pyrenees
- Bernese Mountain Dogs
- Saint Bernard
- Great Dane
- Mastiffs
- Akita
- Irish Wolfhounds
- And again yes, some Doodle Breeds

All large breed dogs that schedule at So Fetch & So Clean need to be on a regular 6-8 week schedule. It takes extra time and effort to large breeds and due to physical limitations, I will not groom dogs who only come in a few times a years and are in matted conditions. Regular scheduling keeps your large breed dog maintain a healthy coat, look great and encourages safe behaviors for grooming.

Doodles

Salina has an abundance of large breed dogs-mainly Doodles and in the past few years the number has increased so much it is overwhelming for the few groomers in town! Doodles are any breed of dog that is mixed with a poodle. These include:

- Labradoodle (Labrador+Poodle)
- Goldendoodle (Golden Retriever+Poodle)
- Bernadoodle (Bernese Mountain Dog+Poodle)
- Cavapoo (Cavaler King Charles Spaniel +Poodle)
- Aussiedoodle (Australian Shepherd+Poodle)
- Sheepadoodle (Old English Sheep Dog+Poodle)
- Yorkiepoo (Yorkie+Poodle)
- Schnoodle (Schnauzer+Poodle)
- Shih-Poo (Shih-Tzu+Poodle)
- Boxerdoodle(Boxer+Poodle)
- Irishdoodle (Irish Setter+Poodle)
- Whoodle (Soft Coated Wheaten+Poodle)
- Cockapoo (Cocker Spaniel+Poodle)
- Shepadoodle (German Shepherd+Poodle)
- Maltipoo (Maltese+Poodle)
- Chipoo (Chihuahua+Poodle)

All Doodle breeds require a large amount of grooming maintenance at home to keep their coats from matting between appointments. If any client is unable to maintain their doodles coat at home and keep regularly scheduled appointments between 6-8 weeks, there is a good chance your Doodle may have to be shaved due to matting.

Because the Doodle is not recognized by the AKC, and breeding is not regulated, Doodle breeds and their coats have become unpredictable. They require more grooming time and effort for the groomer. Owners should expect higher groom prices, longer groom times and they need to understand a haircut or style that works for one Doodle, may not work for yours. I will not tolerate rude behavior from clients if I am unable to accomplish a specific cut.
